Participants are asked to arrive by 5:00 PM on Friday at the Henry Sawyer Inn, at which time they will receive a dossier of information; you may be a murderer, victim, supporting character, or sleuth. At 6:00 PM, all will gather to receive instructions from Detective Smith and begin to search for the truth and review the crime scene. You will enjoy wine and hors d'oeuvres, while you begin the investigative process. At 7:00 PM, all will adjourn to one of Cape May's fine restaurants for dinner, relaxation, and some investigative work with Detective Smith.

On Saturday morning at 10:30 AM, after breakfast at the inn, all will meet together with Detective Smith, who will update everyone on overnight developments. You will continue your investigation and questioning until Noon.

The afternoon will be free time to enjoy Cape May and solve the crime. You will have one final chance to examine the evidence and question others at tea at 4:00 PM. Each person will complete his or her who-dun-it sheet and turn it in to Detective Smith by 5:00 PM. All will reconvene at 8:30 PM at the inn to enjoy a dessert reception, at which time the crime solution will be revealed and prizes awarded.

On Sunday morning, all will enjoy a lovely breakfast at the inn.
